Sleep Apnea: What is it and are you at risk?

Sleep apnea is a common condition in which your breathing stops and restarts many times while you

sleep. This can prevent your body from getting enough oxygen. Sleep apnea creates insufficient sleep

which has been linked to the development of a number of health complications and chronic diseases:

Sleep Apnea Complications:

- Increase risk of vehicle or workplace accidents due to daytime fatigue
- Cardiovascular disease: High blood pressure or heart problems.
- Type 2 diabetes: Higher risk of insulin resistance
- Depression
- Obesity

What Are the Symptoms of Sleep Apnea?

- Snoring
- Breathing that starts and stops during sleep
- Waking up suddenly after gasping or choking
- Fatigue or sleepiness during the day
- Restlessness while sleeping, or regular nighttime awakenings
- Dry mouth or sore throat when you wake up
- Trouble concentrating, forgetfulness, or crankiness
- Depression or anxiety
- Constant need to go pee at night
- Night sweats
- Headaches

How Doctors Diagnose Sleep Apnea

- Medical history
- Physical exam
- Sleep Studies: Your doctor may refer you to a sleep specialist or a center for a sleep study.

Sleep Apnea Home Remedies

- Lose weight: About half of people with sleep apnea are overweight
- Don't use alcohol and sleeping pills: They decrease the muscle tone in the back of your throat
- Change sleep positions: You may breathe more easily if you stay off your back

- Stop smoking: Smoking increases swelling in the upper airway, making snoring and apnea worse
- Treat allergies. Nasal allergies swell tissues in your airways making it harder to breathe

Sleep Apnea Medical Treatments

- Continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) machine: You wear a mask over your nose or mouth
- while you sleep. The mask is hooked up to a machine that delivers air flow into your nose
- Automatic positive airway pressure (APAP): CPAP machine does not helpful
- Oral Appliances: Dental devices can help keep your airway open while you sleep

Make an appt with your doctor if you are experiencing symptoms of sleep apnea.

CA NEW WORKPLACE VIOLENCE STANDARDS

California has passed SB 553 requiring employers create and implement a Workplace Violence Prevention Plan (WVPP) by July 1, 2024. The new law applies to most California employers, large and small - with exceptions to healthcare employers already covered under the existing healthcare WVPP Standard.

Developing and implementing the plan will be a significant undertaking for employers since the standard requires comprehensive multi-prong procedures, including; identifying and evaluating unsafe conditions in the workplace and responding to, investigating and report workplace violence incidents. Employers must also conduct interactive training for employees covering their tailored WVPP's and the workplace violence hazards specific to their employees' iobs.

These elements must be incorporated into the plan document and implemented, including: *An assessment of workplace violence risks upon developing the plan

*Management Communications with employees regarding workplace violence risks and how to respond to emergencies

*Post-incident response and investigation *Steps to ensure employee compliance with the plan *Procedures for reviewing the effectiveness of the plan and making revisions *Topics required for annual interactive training of employees on workplace violence prevention plan

*Practical tips for implementing the plan to comply with the new law and best protect your employees

CALIFORNIA MANDATES WORKPLACE POSTER HAVE YOU COMPLIED?

The California Civil Rights Department (CRD) has issued an updated version of the required <u>"California</u> <u>Law Prohibits Workplace Discrimination and Harassment"</u> poster. The update includes information about protections for employees taking bereavement leave or the newly enacted reproductive loss leave.

Like all other required postings, the updated poster must be displayed at the workplace in a conspicuous place where employees gather, and where it can be read by all employees and job applicants. The text has to be large and legible enough to be easily read when posted.


